The Lord's Prayer: The Great Themes of Discipleship

Jesus taught his disciples how to pray and by doing so - disciplined them. The Lord's Prayer has been called the Anthem of the Kingdom of God. It contains 7 great themes of discipleship essential to the life of a disciple.

Discipleship Theme #1

Reconciliation and relationship with God - *Our Father in heaven*

Discipleship Theme #2

Living for the glory and fame of God - *Hallowed be your name*

Discipleship Theme #3

Mission of advancing the rule & righteousness of God - *Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven*

Discipleship Theme #4

Trusting God for every need - *Give us today our daily bread*

Discipleship Theme #5

Receiving and extending relationship restoring mercy - *Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us*

Discipleship Theme #6

Overcoming the two enemies of sin and Satan - *Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil*

Discipleship Theme #7

Praise filled victorious faith - *For yours is the kingdom, power, and glory forever; Amen:*
