Sunday - Our Father in heaven

Position with God as sons and daughters

Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy. - *Matthew 6:9*

Jesus said, "This is how you should pray. Father, may our name be kept holy. May your Kingdom come soon. - *Luke 11:2*

...one God and Father of all who is above all and through all and in all. - *Ephesians 4:6*

...yet for us there is one God, the Father. All things are from him, and we exist for him. And there is one Lord, Jesus Christ. All things are through him, and we exist through him. - *1 Corinthians 8:6*

And I will be a Father to you, and you will be sons and daughters to me, says the Lord Almighty. - *2 Corinthians 6:18*

Do not call anyone on earth our father, because you have one Father, who is in heaven. - *Matthew 23:9*

And because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba, Father!" So you are longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then God has made you an heir. - *Galatians 4:6-7*

For all those led by God's Spirit are God's sons. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear. Instead you received the spirit of adoption, by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father!" The Spirit himself testifies together with our spirit that we are God's children, and if children, also heirs - heirs of God and coheirs with Christ - if indeed we suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him. - *Romans 8:14-16*

Monday - Hallowed be your name

Glory and fame of God

Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy. - *Matthew 6:9*

Jesus said, "This is how you should pray. Father, may our name be kept holy. May your Kingdom come soon. - *Luke 11:2*

"My name will be great among the nations, from the rising of the sun to its setting. Incense and pure offerings will be presented in my name in every place because my name will be great among the nations," says the LORD of Armies. - *Malachi 1:11*

...so at the name of Jesus every knee will bow - in heaven and on earth and under the earth - and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. - *Philippians 2:10-11*

Then I will continually sing of your name, fulfilling my vows day by day. - *Psalms 61:8*

I am the LORD, That is my name, and I will not give my glory to another or my praise to idols. - *Isaiah 42:8*

For a child will be born for us, a son will be given to us, and the government will be on his shoulders. He will be named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. - Isaiah 9:6

The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are protected. - *Proverbs 18:10*

Tuesday - Your Kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven

God's heavenly rule filling every life and place on earth

Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. - *Matthew 6:10*

He said to them, "Whenever you pray, say, Father, your name be honored as holy. Your kingdom come. - *Luke 11:2*

But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you. - *Matthew 6:33*

"I pray not only for these, but also for those who believe in me through their word. May they all be one, as you, Father are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us, so that the world may believe you sent me. - *John 17:20-21*

...for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit. - *Romans 14:17*

In the days of those kings, the God of heavens will set up a kingdom that will never be destroyed, and this kingdom will not be left to another people. It will crush all these kingdoms and bring them to an end, but will itself endure forever. - *Daniel 2:44*

"I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will have been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will have been loosed in heaven." - *Matthew 16:19*

Wednesday - Give us today our daily bread

Provision for daily needs for individuals, families, and the poor

Give us today our daily bread. - *Matthew 6:11*

"If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?" - *Luke 11:13*

And my God will supply all your needs according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus. - *Philippians 4:19*

"So don't worry, saying, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or 'What will we wear?' For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them." - *Matthew 6:31-32*

"But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you." - *Matthew 6:33*

The Lord is my shepherd; I have what I need. - Psalms 23:1

Young lions lack food and go hungry, but those who seek the LORD will not lack any good thing. - *Psalms 34:10*

"Consider the ravens: They don't sow or reap; they don't have a storeroom or a barn; yet God feeds them. Aren't you worth much more than the birds?" - *Luke 12:24*

Keep your life free from the love of money. Be satisfied with what you have, for he himself has said, I will never leave you or abandon you. - *Hebrews 13:5*

Now the one who provides seed for the sower and bread for food will also provide and multiply your seed and increase the harvest of your righteousness. You will be enriched in every way for all generosity, which produces thanksgiving to God through us. - 2 Corinthians 9:8-11

Don't store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves don't break in and steal. For where your treasures are, there your heart will be also.

The eye is the lamp of the body. If our eye is healthy, your whole body will be full of light. But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. So if the light within you is darkness, how deep is that darkness!

No one can serve two masters, since either he will hate one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money. - *Matthew 6:19-24*

Honor the LORD with your possessions and with the first produce of your entire harvest; then your barns will be completely filled, and your vats will overflow with new wine. - *Proverbs 3:9-10*

I am the LORD your God, who brought you up from the land of Egypt. Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it. - *Psalms 81:10*

They have mouths but cannot speak, eyes, but cannot see. - *Psalms 155:5*

Thursday - Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us

Culture of mercy and forgiveness that leads to unity

And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. - *Matthew 6:12*

And forgive us our sins, for we ourselves also forgive everyone in debt to us. And do not bring us into temptation. - *Luke 11:4*

And be kind and compassionate to one another, just as God also forgave you in Christ. - *Ephesians 4:32*

"And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven will also forgive you your wrongdoing." - *Mark 11:32*

Then Peter approached him and asked, "Lord, how many times must I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? As many as seven times?"

I tell you, not as many as seven, "Jesus replied, "but seventy times seven." - Matthew 18:21-22

"Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. - *Luke 6:37*

...bearing with one another and forgiving one another if anyone has a grievance against another. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you are also to forgive. - *Colossians 3:13*

Rise up, Lord God! Lift up your hand. Do not forget the oppressed. - *Psalms 10:12*

No temptation has come upon you except what is common to humanity. But God is faithful; he will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation he will also provide the way out so that you may be able to bear it. - *1 Corinthians 10:13*

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. - *1 John 1:9*

Whoever conceals an offense promotes love, but whoever gossips about it separates friends. - *Proverbs 17:9*

Be gracious to me, God, according to your faithful love; according to your abundant compassion, blot out my rebellion. Completely wash away my guilt and cleanse me from my sin. For I am conscious of my rebellion, and my sin is always before me. Against you - you alone - I have sinned and done this evil in your sight. So you are right when you pass sentence; you are blameless when you judge. Indeed, I was guilty when I was born; I was sinful when my mother conceived me.

Surely you desire integrity in the inner self, and you teach me wisdom deep within. Purify me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones you have crushed rejoice. Turn your face away from my sins and blot out all my guilt.

God create a clean heart for me and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not banish me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore the joy of your salvation to me, and sustain me by giving me a willing spirit. Then I will teach the rebellious your ways, and sinners will return to you.

Save me from the guilt of bloodshed, God - God of my salvation - and my tongue will sing of your righteousness. Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise. You do not want a sacrifice, or I would give it; you are not pleased with a burnt offering. The sacrifice pleasing to God is a broken spirit. You will not despise a broken and humbled heart, God.

In your good pleasure, cause Zion to prosper; build the walls of Jerusalem. Then you will delight in righteous sacrifices, whole burnt offerings; then bulls will be offered on your alter. - *Psalms 51*

As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. - Psalm 103:12

"I pray not only for these, but also for those who believe in me through their word. May they all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us, so that the world may believe you sent me. I have given them the glory you have given me, so that they may be one as we are one. I am in them and you are in me, so that they may be made completely one, that the world may know you have sent me and have loved them as have loved me. - *John 17:20-23*

Friday - Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil

Warfare: protection from sin and Satan

And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. - *Matthew 6:13*

And forgive us our sins, for we ourselves also forgive everyone in debt to us. And do not bring us into temptation. - *Luke 11:13*

Put on the full armor of God so that you can stand against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this darkness, against evil forces in the heavens. - *Ephesians 6:11-12*

For although we live in the flesh, we do not wage war according to the flesh, since the weapons of our warfare are not the flesh, but are powerful through God for the demolition of strongholds. We demolish arguments and every proud thing that is raised up against the knowledge of God, and we take every thought captive to obey Christ. - 2 Corinthians 10:3-5

Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. - *James 4:7*

Be sober-minded, be alert. Your adversary the devil is prowling around like a roaring lion, looking for anyone he can devour. - *1 Peter 5:8*

I say then, walk by the Spirit and you will certainly not carry out the desire of the flesh. - *Galatians 5:16*

The one who lives under the protection of the Most High dwells in the shadow of the Almighty.

I will say concerning the LORD, who is my refuge and my fortress, my God in whom I trust: He himself will rescue you from the bird trap, from the destructive plague. He will cover you with his feathers; you will take refuge under his wings. His faithfulness will be a protective shield. You will not fear the terror of the night, the arrow that flies by day, the plague that stalks in darkness, or the pestilence that ravages at noon. Though a thousand fall at your side and ten thousand at your right hand, the pestilence will not reach you. You will only see it with eyes and witness the punishment of the wicked.

Because you have made the LORD - my refuge, the Most High - your dwelling place, no harm will come to you; no plague will come near your tent. For he will give his angels orders concerning you, to protect

you in all your ways. They will support you with their hands so that you will not strike your foot against a stone. You will tread on the lion and the cobra; you will trample the young lion and the serpent.

Because he has his heart set on me, I will deliver him; I will protect him because he knows my name. When he calls out to me, I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble. I will rescue him with a long life and show him my salvation. - *Psalm 91*

Look, I have given you the authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy; nothing at all will harm you. - *Luke 10:19*

No weapon formed against you will succeed, and you will refute any accusation raised against you in court. This is the heritage of the LORD's servants, and their vindication is from me. This is the LORD's declaration. - *Isaiah 54:17*

For the LORD God is a sun and shield. The LORD grants favor and honor; he does not withhold the good from those who live with integrity. - *Psalms 84:11*

...because everyone who has been born of God conquers the world. This is the victory that has conquered the world: our faith. - *1 John 5:4*

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. - Romans 8:37

Now since the children have flesh and blood in common, Jesus also shared in these, so that through his death he might destroy the one holding the power of death - that is, the devil - *Hebrews 2:14*

...so that your fasting isn't obvious to others but to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you. - *Matthew 6:18*

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you, and the rivers will not overwhelm you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be scorched, and the flame will not burn you. - *Isaiah 43:2*

For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be rendered powerless so that we may no longer be enslaved to sin, since a person who has died is freed from sin. - *Romans 6:6*

They conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; for they did not love their lives to the point of death. - *Revelations 12:11*

Saturday - For yours is the kingdom, power, and glory forever; Amen.

Declaring the Lord's victory

And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. - *Matthew 6:13*

Each of the four living creatures had six wings; they were covered with eyes around and inside. Day and night they never stop, saying,

Holy, holy, holy,

Lord God, the Almighty,

Who was, who is and who is to come. - Revelation 4:8

Our Lord and God, you are worthy to receive glory and honor and power, because you have created all things, and by your will they exist and were created. - *Revelations 4:11*

And they sang a new song:

You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slaughtered, and you purchased people for God by your blood from every tribe and language and people and nation. You made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they will reign on the earth. - *Revelations 5:9-10*

They said with a loud voice,

Worthy is the Lamb who was slaughtered to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing!

I heard every creature in heaven, on earth, under the earth, on the sea, and everything in them say, Blessing and honor and power be to the one seated on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!

The four living creatures said, "Amen," and the elders fell down and worshiped. - *Revelations 5:12-14*

And they cried out in a loud voice:

Salvation belongs to our God, who is seated on the throne, and to the Lamb! - *Revelations 7:10*

All the angels stood around the throne, and along with the elders and the four living creatures they fell facedown before the throne and worshiped God, saying,

Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and strength be to our God forever and ever. Amen. - *Revelations 7:11-12*

For this reason they are before the throne of God, and they serve him day and night in his temple. The one seated on the throne will shelter them: They will no longer hunger; they will no longer thirst; the sun will no longer strike them, nor will any scorching heat. For the Lamb who is the center of the throne will shepherd them; he will guide them to springs of the waters of life, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes. - *Revelations 7:15-17*

The seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven saying,

The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he will reign forever and ever.

The twenty-four elders, who were seated before God on their thrones, fell facedown and worshiped God, saying,

We give you thanks, Lord God, the Almighty, who is and who was, because you have taken your great power and have begun to reign. - *Revelations 11:15-17*

Then I heard a loud voice in heaven say,

The salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Christ have now come, because the accuser of our brothers and sisters, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been thrown down. They conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; for they did not love their lives to the point of death. - *Revelations 12:10-11*

Now to him who is able to protect you from stumbling and to make you stand in the presence of his glory, without blemish and with great joy, to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, power, and authority before all time, now and forever. Amen. - *Jude 24-25*

For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the LORD's glory, as the water covers the sea. - Habakkuk 2:14

And one called to another:

Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of Armies; his glory fills the whole earth. - *Isaiah 6:3*

Hallelujah! Praise the LORD from the heavens; praise him in the heights. Praise him, all his angles; praise him, all his heavenly armies. Praise him, sun and moon; praise him, all you shining stars. Praise him, highest heavens, and you waters above the heavens. Let them praise the name of the LORD, for he commanded, and they were created. He sent them in position forever and ever; he gave an order that will never pass away.

Praise the LORD from the earth, all sea monsters and ocean depths, lightning and hail, snow and cloud, stormy wind that executes his command, mountains and all hills, fruit trees and all cedars, wild animals and all cattle, creatures that crawl and flying birds, kings of the earth and all peoples, princes and all judges of the earth, young men as well as young women, old and young together. Let them praise the name of the LORD, for his name alone is exalted. His majesty covers heaven and earth. He has raised up a horn for his people, resulting in praise to all his faithful ones, to the Israelites, the people close to him. Hallelujah! - *Psalms 148*

Hallelujah! Sing to the LORD a new song, his praise in the assembly of the faithful. Let Israel celebrate its Maker; let the children of Zion rejoice in their King. Let them praise his name with dancing and make music to him with tambourine and lyre. For the LORD takes pleasure in his people; he adorns the humble with salvation. Let the faithful celebrate in triumphal glory; let them shout for joy on their beds.

Let the exaltation of God be in their mouths and a double-edged sword in their hands, inflicting vengeance on the nations and punishment on the peoples, binding their kings with chains and their dignitaries with iron shackles, carrying out the judgement decreed against them. This honor is for all his faithful people. Hallelujah! - Psalms 149

Hallelujah! Praise God in his sanctuary. Praise him in his mighty expanse. Praise him for his powerful acts; praise him for his abundant greatness.

Praise him with the blast of a ram's horn; praise him with harp and lyre. Praise him with tambourine and dance; praise him with strings and flute. Praise him with resounding cymbals; praise him clashing cymbals.

Let everything that breathes praise the LORD. Hallelujah! - *Psalms 150*
